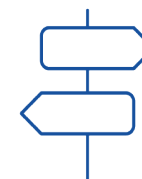

On 17 November, Training without Borders (TWB) will explore alongside its international partners ongoing and future mobility projects in vocational education and training (VET).

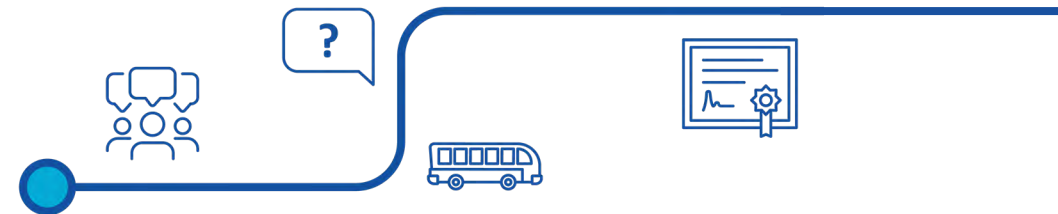
